I would like to request to see all internal reports and communications about successful hacking and other computer related attacks on government assets.

Please also include estimates of how much data has stolen in the past two years and the nature of this data.

The Scotland Office shares an information technology system with the Scottish Government, which is responsible for the development, administration, security and maintenance of the system. They comply with the mandatory requirements of the Security Policy Framework in relation to information security including managing the risk of unauthorised access to ICT systems. The Scotland Office does not hold the information requested. However, I can inform you that the Scotland Office has no record of having data stolen in the past two years.
